DIRECTIONS TO SHOWGROUND

Geldeston Hall NR34 0LP is 15 miles south of Norwich, west of the A146-A143 intersection miles north of Beccles. Turn towards Bungay/Diss, and signs will take you to the venue. Competitors south of Ipswich (A12) are recommended to take the A45 westbound, then A140 to Scole and join the A143 eastwards.

LATE ENTRIES

RULES

1. The Beccles & Bungay Riding Club, official helpers and landowners cannot accept liability for any damage, loss, accident, injury or illness to any person, horse or property however caused in respect of or in connection with or arising out of this event.
2. **Health and Safety Policy** The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards, and avoid activities likely to cause accidents. Ambulances and emergency services must have access to all parts of the show-ground and members of the public and their vehicles must not obstruct access. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's safety and control.
3. This event is run under the current Official Rules for British Riding Clubs Competitions.
4. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate.
5. **All competitors at BRC Area events** must wear correct riding clothes and riding hats must show aqua tags or be checked and tagged at the Secretary's tent. The following hat types are accepted by BRC :
6. Excessive work or misuse of whips or spurs anywhere on the showground may incur the intervention of the Official Steward and possible elimination.
7. Lunging must only take place in the lunging area, and not in the lorry parking or warm-up areas.
8. Competitors are requested not to skip out horseboxes onto the grass, and to pick up all rubbish.
