We kindly request that each club provides two helpers for the day (one for Seniors & one for Juniors). Most helpers will be dressage writing for a complete section, and a few will be stewarding. Please confirm with your entry who the nominated helpers are.

If you are only entering either Junior or Senior, then only one helper is required. It is fine for one helper to cover both Junior and Senior if they are happy to stay for the duration of the whole day. If the helper is a rider we will do our level best to offer appropriate times, within the confines of a drawn order. Entries without helpers sadly cannot be accepted.

## Rules

This competition will run under BRC Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition. Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. All competitors must be registered on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier and anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed. Numbers to qualify as per Appendix 10 dependant on Appendix 9 in the current BRC Handbook.

All clubs must submit a pre-entry to BRC at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (20<sup>th</sup> June). Preentries can be made via the pre-entry website <u>https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect</u>. Late preentries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual and £20 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore <u>must</u> <u>not</u> be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained. Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details outlined on this schedule.

### Flu Vaccinations (6 monthly)

Flu vaccinations will be checked in advance- Please submit all flu vaccinations with your entries. Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. ## Substitutions

To be made by email up to 24 hours in advance up to Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July and passports submitted with substitutions. After that, all substitutions to be made on the day. (Note Anna Goodley unavailable on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July as at a wedding!)

#### Times

Times will be available the Friday evening before the competition- these will be emailed to team managers and on the Area 14 facebook page. Seniors will compete in the morning, Juniors in the afternoon

#### Cancellation

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

#### Hats

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

#### EHV

Given the EHV outbreak in Europe, sadly now also in the UK, horses may not enter the venue from any yard with signs of illness or any at risk yards who have had horses arrive from abroad and follow any guidelines issued from the BRC.

#### Photos

There will be photographers in attendance but due to having eight arenas running, it will not be possible to capture every competitor.
