**RULES**

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below:

All qualifier entrants must pay a prelim entry of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries [www.britishridingclubs.org.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.org.uk) or online entries can be made via [www.brc.bhs.org.uk/prelims](http://www.brc.bhs.org.uk/prelims). Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

**\*Single Phase is a course in two parts with second part timed. All will jump against the clock immediately after their first round, even with faults unless eliminated. Winner is the rider with the fewest (or zero) faults with the fastest time in the second section.**

## **BRC HAT STANDARDS**

All hats must have a visible **orange** BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards.

Hats to be worn when mounted, and all hats need to be tagged with the **turquoise 2018 tag**. Please note that BSEN1384 and PAS 015 are no longer eligible unless supported by the BSI kite mark. Hats from abroad need to show one of the following quality assurance marks: SEI, SNELL plus number reference, or SAI Global mark. There will be a trained official available on the day who will check your hat for compliance with BRC hat standards and if it passes will tag it. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC rule book.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Other than the team competitions, all heights are approximate. Judges/Secretary have the right to refuse any entries and the Judge's decision is final. Finn Valley Riding Club accepts no responsibility for any damage to horses, people or their property.

From Debenham – take Gracechurch street out of the village, past High School and Community Centre, follow road for 2 miles, ignoring turning to Mickfield. Tophorn Equestrian Centre is 1 mile at top of hill on your right hand side.
