#### **RULES**

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. All qualifier entrants must pay a prelim entry of £32 per team or £10 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries <a href="www.britishridingclubs.org.uk">www.britishridingclubs.org.uk</a> or online entries can be made via www.brc.bhs.org.uk/prelims. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge fee, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

\*Single Phase is a course in two parts with second part timed. All will jump against the clock immediately after their first round, even with faults unless eliminated. Winner is the rider with the fewest (or zero) faults and the fastest time in the second section.

#### Format for the Qualifier

Riders jump two rounds. Riders will jump the first round and then another round. The second round will be run as a single phase competition, so the first part of the course will be the second round, followed by the second part of the course which will be classed as the jump-off. The jump-off will follow straight on from the first part of the course without stopping. All team and individual members will go forward to the second part of the second round (jump-off) unless eliminated. Should a team member be eliminated before reaching the jump-off phase and that team are tied for any placing, the team with the 4th member will take priority. For scoring purposes the second round and jump-off will be scored separately. At the discretion of the area, for team placings the second round times may be used to gain a result.

Approximate times will be provided once the entries have been received.

#### **BRC HAT STANDARDS**

All hats must have a visible **turquoise** BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. Hats to be worn when mounted, and all hats need to tagged with the **turquoise 2018 tag**. Please note that BSEN1384 and PAS 015 are no longer eligible unless supported by the BSI kite mark. Hats from abroad need to show one of the following quality assurance marks: SEI, SNELL plus number reference, or SAI Global mark. There will be a trained official available on the day who will check your hat for compliance with BRC hat standards and if it passes will tag it. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC rule book.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Please also be advised that Topthorn state 6 monthly boosters are mandatory to enter their venue.

Other than the team competitions, all heights are approximate. Judges/Secretary have the right to refuse any entries and the Judge's decision is final. Finn Valley Riding Club accepts no responsibility for any damage to horses, people or their property.
