1Q	Introduction A (2008) (Individual Only Qualifier) ENTRY FEE £12.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Up to 35 Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. British Eventing Points: 0 Points Horses cannot have competed in novice or above in the current or previous competition year, British Dressage or British Riding Clubs. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BD Groups 1 – 7 (b), (c). Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or above during the last 3 calendar years
2Q/2A	Preliminary 7 (2002) ENTRY FEE £12.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible.
3Q/3A	Preliminary 12 (2005) ENTRY FEE £12.50	Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, British Dressage or British Riding Clubs. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BRC Eq 4, BD Groups 1 – 6 (b), (c). Riders cannot have competed at BE Intermediate or above during the last 3 calendar years
4Q/4A	Novice 28 (2008) ENTRY FEE £12.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above.
5Q/5A	Novice 30 (2006) ENTRY FEE £12.50	Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BD Groups 1-5 (b). (c)

Those with borrowed horses or ponies should check eligibility on points.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2019 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

IMPORTANT All hats must have a visible **AQUA BRC hat tag** in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Equine influenza

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Objections and queries

Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

Health & Safety Policy

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the showground and members of the public and their vehicles must not block access. REFUNDS for entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

DOGS are not allowed in the café or arenas. Please keep on a lead at all times.

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of incident or results being published with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

RESERVATION: the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS: Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn, but must be shown on both sides of the horse.

SPECIAL NOTICES:

- Lunging is not permitted.
- Please do not muck out lorries or trailers onto the car park.
- No horses or ponies must be left tied unattended to lorries or trailers.
- Please observe and respect all signs displayed by Easton & Otley College Equestrian or Halesworth & District Riding Club.

Note: Classes 2A,3A,4A,5A,6A,7A,8A,9A are Area Trophy Phase Classes only, no Prelim entry needed.

ALL team members are automatically entered into the individual competition

Horses & Riders may compete at both Winter Novice and Intermediate Dressage (November 17th), providing they comply with the eligibility criteria

Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different and only one test is as part of a team.

Entry Fees:

All entrants must pay a Prelim entry of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier.

Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena appendix 11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place.

Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.
