COMPETITION PROCEDURES FOR THIS EVENT

Results will be emailed to Team Managers and published on our Website and Facebook Page by Tuesday March 8th.

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- Anyone displaying symptoms of illness will be asked to leave the venue. Please ensure temperatures of all attending are checked before leaving home
- The organisers ask that horses/ponies are not left tied to their trailers/lorries whilst unattended.
- Please observe and respect any signs displayed by Martley Hall or HDRC.
- Please clear away and take home any litter or droppings.
- Lunging is not permitted.

Equine influenza & Microchip Numbers

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

All horses/ponies attending a qualifier or championship must be micro chipped.

Vaccination Records, Passports and Microchip Numbers will need to be validated by the Official Steward before the day of competition. Team Managers can advise you of the new checking procedure

Objections and queries Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

Health & Safety Policy

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards, and avoid activities likely to cause accidents. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the showground and members of the public and their vehicles must not block access. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's safety and control.

LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

REFUNDS for entry fees made to HDRC refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

DOGS must be kept on leads at all times

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing to the Official Steward within 30 minutes of incident or results being published or in the case of protests against qualification of horses/ponies 60 minutes after the start of the class with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

RESERVATION: the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS: Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn, but must be shown on both sides of the horse. Number Bibs are also acceptable (A number template is available to download from the BRC Downloads page.)

CHILDREN: under the age of 14yrs MUST be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Professional and Amateur photographers may attend our competitions, upon entering classes you are deemed to have accepted that photographs may be taken of Seniors and possibly used for publicity purposes.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to all tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules.

The full 2022 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

ALL RIDING HATS must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Entry Fees:

Pre-entries must be made for every team **£36** and/or individual **£11** per class entering any qualifier and completed by a senior club representative (or by an individual BRC Member) to the BRC Office 21 days before the area qualifier, with appropriate fees.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser. Team managers must contact the organiser to seek permission for a late entry in the first instance to see if there is space. Late pre-entries must be made online and will be subject to a £10 surcharge per individual or pair and £20 per team. Posted or emailed pre-entries will not be accepted until payment has been received.

When posting separately please ensure payment is sent in good time for the closing date. If received after the closing date the entry/entries may be subject to late fee charges.

Pre-entry forms can be found on the BRC website on the BRC downloads page. Or you may enter online using the BRC entry system. <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/select>

There will be no return of pre-entry fees however a credit note may be issued at the discretion of BRC providing the request is sent in before the closing date of pre-entries.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.
