Class 1/1A* Junior Winter Dressage Prelim Section(Qualifier)	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, BD or BRC. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BRC Eq 4, BD Groups 1 – 6 (b), (c). Test: Prelim 12 (2005)
Class 2/2A* Junior Winter Dressage Novice Section (Qualifier)	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above. Horses downgraded to 124 points under the BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BD Groups 1-5 (b) Test: Novice 28 (2008)
Class 3/3A* Senior Winter Dressage Prelim Section (Qualifier)	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, BD or BRC. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BRC Eq 4, BD Groups 1 – 6 (b), (c). Test: Prelim 12 (2005)
Class 4/4A* Senior Winter Dressage Novice Section (Qualifier)	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above. Horses downgraded to 124 points under the BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BD Groups 1-5 (b) Test: Novice 28 (2008)

- (a) Qualification not to have been gained within the past ten years
- (b) Refers to active members of BD during the last 3 years calendar years
- (c) Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years

In the Novice team competitions 2 members of each team ride the Prelim test, and 2 ride the Novice test.

Classes 1A/2A/3A and 4A are AREA competitions only.

ELIGIBILITY

Those with borrowed horses should check eligibility on points and winnings.

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £28 per team or £9 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena appendix11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place. for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sort.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2018 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

All hats must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Equine influenza

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Objections and queries

Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

Health & Safety Policy

SPECIAL NOTICES:

- Lunging is not permitted.
- Please do not muck out lorries or trailers onto the car park.
- No horses or ponies must be left tied unattended to lorries or trailers.
- Please observe and respect all signs displayed by Easton & Otley College or HDRC.

No pony or horse may compete more than once on the same day in the same discipline at any championship, except for Dressage and Riding Test competitions when they may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different and only one test is as part of a team.

Horses may compete in both Winter Novice and Intermediate Dressage Competitions.

Horses that have competed at Elementary dressage level or above in BD affiliated competitions or BRC Official Competition in the current competition year may not compete in Prelim dressage tests, other than in the Prelim section of the Winter Intermediate Dressage if other eligibility criteria is met.
