Rules:

This competition is run under current British Riding Clubs rules unless superseded by the rules below. The current BRC Handbook and Rule Amendments document can be found on: https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brchandbook/

Showground Rules and Rules of Entry

- 1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- 2. The organisers ask that horses/ponies are not left tied to their trailers/lorries whilst unattended. No haynets to be tied to lorries/trailers
- 3. Please clear away and take home any litter or droppings.
- 4. Lungeing is not permitted.
- 5. Please observe and respect any signs displayed by Easton College and Carleton Riding Club.
- 6. Non towing cars must not be left in the horse box car parks.
- 7. DOGS must be kept on leads at all times
- 8. OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of incident or results being published with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.
- 9. RESERVATION: the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.
- 10. COMPETITOR NUMBERS: Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn, but must be shown on both sides of the horse. Number Bibs are also acceptable (A number template is available to download from the BRC Downloads page.)
- 11. CHILDREN: under the age of 14yrs MUST be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- 12. Photography of Juniors: Professional and Amateur photographers may attend our competitions, upon entering classes you are deemed to have accepted that photographs may be taken of Juniors and possibly used for publicity purposes.
- 13. If entries are over-subscribed we will limit the number of teams per club by means of a ballot.
- 14. Day Format Every care will be taken to reduce waiting times and consideration will be given to those traveling furthest. Requests can be made, and we will do our best to accommodate, however we will also apply fairness to arranging the times.
- 15. <u>IMPORTANT</u> ALL team riders are automatically entered into the individual competition Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different. No horse may compete twice for one team or in more than one team in the same competition unless expressly permitted.
- 16. In the event of bad weather, the organiser reserve the right to cancel and where possible, reschedule. If this is not possible, a ballot will take place to determine qualifying places.

Entries:

1. For Winter qualifiers and onwards, BRC has introduced a 'competition pass' this will take the place of Pre-Entries. To compete and qualify for BRC championships, all

- entrants must have a valid club membership AND a valid competition pass, which can be purchased via the BRC Sport80 portal. Any member competing at a qualifier without both club membership and a competition pass will be disqualified.
- **2.** It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria, the eligibility table can be found here: https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brchandbook/
- **3.** This is a mixed competition, open to senior & junior teams and individuals, teams maybe any combination of senior and/or junior, with 3 scores to count. All team members are automatically entered into the individual competition. One member member will ride a prelim test, two team members will ride different novice tests and one team member will ride an elementary test.
- **4.** Horses can only compete in 2 consecutive classes (ie Intro & Prelim or Prelim & Novice)
- **5.** Closing date for entries is Friday 14th November by using the spreadsheet supplied and emailed to michaelacanham@aol.com by this date. Late entries will be considered space allowing and will incur a premium of £5 extra per class.
- **6.** First aid will be in attendance and will be charged at £3.00 per competitor
- **7.** Withdrawal/cancellation/refund policy no refunds will be given after the close date. Refunds will only be issued with a valid doctor's certificate or veterinary certificate.

Tack & Turnout:

- **1.** All **riding hats** must have a visible current BRC/BE/PC pink hat tag. Tagging will be available by the official steward on the day. Please allow sufficient time prior to your test for this to be completed,
- **2.** A **body protector** is not mandatory for this competition.
- **3.** Riders wearing Exo-Body cages, in which the BETA Level 3 2009 Purple Label, must inform the official steward/organiser before the event.

Health and Safety guidelines:

- 1. The gates to the horse transport parks must be kept closed for the safety of horse
- 2. and ponies
- 3. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the showground and members of the public and their vehicles must not block access.
- 4. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's safety and control.
- 5. LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. All horses must be microchipped.
