Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or BD or BRC Novice Dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year. |
| 2Q | Preliminary 7 (2002) ENTRY FEE £14.00 | Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Prelim Points, up to 35 points at Novice or above. |
| 3Q | Preliminary 12 (2005) ENTRY FEE £14.00 | Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Horses cannot have competed in BD or BRC Elementary or above in the same competition year. Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or BD or BRC Elementary Dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year. |
| 4Q | Novice 24 (2010) ENTRY FEE £14.00 | Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Novice points, up to 35 Elementary points and 0 points at Medium or above. |
| 5Q | Novice 27 (2007) ENTRY FEE £14.00 | Horses downgraded to 124 points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Riders cannot have competed at BE Intermediate or BD or BRC Medium dressage or above in the current calendar year. |

Riders must not have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, or competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years

Those with borrowed horses or ponies should check eligibility on points and winnings.

Rules of entry

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- The organisers ask that horses/ponies are not left tied to their trailers/lorries whilst unattended.
- Please clear away and take home any litter or droppings.
- Lungeing is not permitted.
- Please observe and respect any signs displayed by Easton College and Carleton Riding Club.
- Non towing cars must not be left in the horse box car parks
- The gates to the horse transport parks must be kept closed for the safety of horses and ponies

Equine Influenza & Microchip Numbers

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with BRC current ruling which has returned to yearly vaccination. Please refer to G7 ruling in the BRC, including any amendments issued by BRC. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. All horses/ponies attending a qualifier or championship must be microchipped.

Vaccination Records, Passports and Microchip Numbers will need to be validated by the Official Steward before the day of competition. We will run with the system for recent area qualifier competitions, whereby copies of passports should be sent to the Official Steward for this competition, Ann McVicar annmcfvivar@btinternet.com by 20th November 2023.

Objections and queries Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

Health & Safety Policy

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards, and avoid activities likely to cause accidents. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the showground and members of the public and their vehicles must not block access. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's safety and control.

LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

REFUNDS for entry fees only on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

DOGS must be kept on leads at all times

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of incident or results being published with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

RESERVATION: the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS: Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn, but must be shown on both sides of the horse. Number Bibs are also acceptable (A number template is available to download from the BRC Downloads page.)

CHILDREN: under the age of 14yrs MUST be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Photography of Juniors: Professional and Amateur photographers may attend our competitions, upon entering classes you are deemed to have accepted that photographs may be taken of Juniors and possibly used for publicity purposes.

Day Format

Every care will be taken to reduce waiting times and consideration will be given to those traveling furthest. Requests can be made, and we will do our best to accommodate, however we will also apply fairness to arranging the times. The timetable plan is as follows, subject to change:

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to all tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2021 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

All hats must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

IMPORTANT

ALL team riders are automatically entered into the individual competition

Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different. No horse may compete twice for one team or in more than one team in the same competition unless expressly permitted.

Entry Fees:

All entrants must pay an additional pre-entry fee of £40 per team or £13 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of this event. The closing date for pre-entry is 4th November 2023.

Entry forms can be found on the BRC website. Online entries via <https://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/area-qualifiers>. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.
