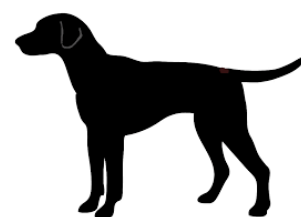
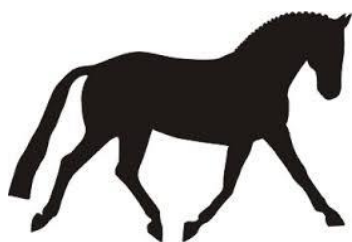

- 1. Best Turned Out In hand & Ridden.** Lead rein permitted.
- 2. Open Lead Rein Pony .** Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.
- 3. Open First Ridden** To be shown in a snaffle bridle only.
- 4. Ridden Pony.** Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
- 5. Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland small breed** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.
- 6. Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland large breed** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell,

Highland, New Forest and Welsh C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
Rider any age.

7. **Part Bred Mountain and Moorland** Open to any unregistered, part bred Mountain and Moorlands. .
8. **Ridden Piebald/Skewbald** Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. Classes may be divided depending on entries.

12. **Ridden Hunter** Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old, any height.
13. **Ridden Cobs** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over.
14. **Ridden Thoroughbreds and Part breeds.** Any height. Rider any age.
15. **Ridden Foreign Breed** Any height, rider any age. any height.
16. **Concours d'Elegance In-hand or ridden.** Lead Rein Allowed. Hard hats must be worn.

17. In Hand Pony In Hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 148cm at maturity.

18. Horse In hand Any horses exceeding 148cm.

19. In Hand Piebald/Skewbald Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. Classes may be divided depending on entries.

20. In Hand Traditionals and Anything Hairy. Horse/ pony any height any colour. Handler any age.

21. In Hand Mountain and Moorland large breed Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh C & D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

22. Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland small breed Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.

23. In Hand Young Stock 1, 2 & 3year old.

25. In Hand Veteran Open mixed age - Horse or Pony aged 15yrs & over.

26. In Hand Cob Type Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over, any height.

27. In Hand Foreign Breeds Horse or pony any height. Any age.

28. Thoroughbreds and Part Breeds Horse or pony any height any age.

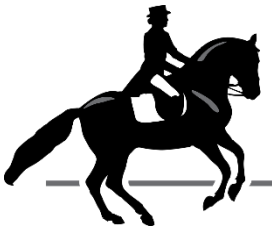

39. Family Horse/Pony. To be ridden by an adult and child under 14 years.

40. Utility pony. Not exc. 148cms. Lead rein permitted.

41. Utility horse. Exc. 148cms.

Utility - To complete a fun obstacle course designed to reflect qualities of a utility pony. Competitors may be required to jump some small fences. A short individual show required. Snaffle bridle only permitted.

1. Mr. and Mrs. K Bertram & the organisers of the show accept no liability in the respect of any accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other persons or personal property whatsoever.
2. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
3. Judges decisions are final.
4. Hard hats must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted to current standards.
5. No horse or pony to compete in any ridden class under the age of 4 years old. Except the young stock class.
6. The organisers reserve the right to split or amalgamate any class.
7. Entry fees are non-returnable.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries for whatever reason.
9. All competitors must have their own third party public liability insurance.
10. Riders & Horses ages are taken from the 1st Jan 2020.
11. Stallion, mare or geldings to compete in any class, unless stated.
12. In hand classes open to all ages.
13. Under 16's must be supervised by a responsible adult.
14. It is the owners/riders responsibility to ensure no horse is over competed and welfare compromised.
15. No judge will be riding horses in classes.
16. Lorries and trailers must not be mucked out onto the show-ground.
17. Interference from outside the ring will result in elimination and asked to leave the ring.
18. In the interest of safety it is only permissible to walk your ponies in the trailer lines, trotting or cantering among them is not allowed.
19. No horse or pony to be left unattended in Lorry Park. The owners of any animal, deemed by officials, to be exhibiting threatening behaviour will be asked to leave the show ground.
