1Q	Prelim 18 (2002) (Individual Only Qualifier) ENTRY FEE £8.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Prelim Points, 35 points at Novice or above. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, BD or British Riding Clubs.
2Q	Novice 28 (2007) ENTRY FEE £8.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above.
3Q	Novice 34 (2009) ENTRY FEE £8.50	
4Q	Elementary 42 (2002) ENTRY FEE £8.50	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BD Points: Unlimited Elementary points, up to 35 Medium points, 0 points at Adv. Med or above.

Those with borrowed horses or ponies should check eligibility on points and winnings.

NEW COMPETITION ANTI VIRAL PROCEDURES FOR BOTH EVENTS

With the current lockdown and ban on non-essential travel in place, it is ESSENTIAL that teams do not break COVID regulations in order to compete. Travelling to and hiring arenas is not permitted at this time.

Results will be emailed to Team Managers and published on our website and Facebook Page on Sunday 28th February. Completed score sheets and rosettes will be posted to team managers week commencing 1st March 2021.

RULES: AS PER BRITISH RIDING CLUBS GUIDELINES

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to all tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2020 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

All hats must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards

Arenas:

Arenas must be measured 20 x 40m and may be on any flat surface including grass and must have arena letters and ideally corners indicated by poles or similar laid on the ground.

Equine influenza & Microchip Numbers

Your horse must have an up to date influenza vaccination within 12 months of the competition. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. From Oct 1 2020 all horses/ponies attending a qualifier or championship must be microchipped.

Vaccination Records, Passports and Microchip Numbers will need to be validated by the Official Steward before the declaration cut off of 15th February. Team managers; please email anmccvicar@btinternet.com with a copy of your team horse's **passport name, vaccination record and microchip page** of their passports. Please send each horse's details individually to avoid confusion with the horse's name, rider and club in the subject heading.

Please can all team managers check everything is complete. If you would like to forward any reserve horses details too then this may help in case of last minute changes.

Objections and queries Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward.

LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

REFUNDS for entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 24 hours results being published with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

RESERVATION: the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

IMPORTANT

ALL team riders are automatically entered into the individual competition

Horses & Riders may compete in BOTH Winter Novice and Intermediate Dressage Classes, providing they comply with the eligibility criteria

Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different. No horse may compete twice for one team or in more than one team in the same competition unless expressly permitted.

Entry Fees:

All entrants must pay an additional Pre entry fee of £32 per team or £10 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 14 days before the submission of video link.

Entry forms can be found on the BRC website. Online entries via <https://brc.bhs.org.uk> late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

Entry Fee £34.00 – per team.

Individual entry fees (if not part of a team) £8.50 per test.
