RULES

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current 2021 BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: http://www.bhs.ora.uk/eniov-ridina/british-ridina-clubs/brc-handbook

All qualifier entrants must pay a prelim entry of £32 per team or £10 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via www.brc.bhs.org.uk/prelims. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge fee, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is changed for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

*Single Phase is a course in two parts with second part timed. All will jump against the clock immediately after their first round, even with faults unless eliminated. Winner is the rider with the fewest (or zero) faults and the fastest time in the second section.

Format for the Qualifier

Riders jump two rounds. Riders will jump the first round and then another round. The second round will be run as a single phase competition, so the first part of the course will be the second round, followed by the second part of the course which will be classed as the jump-off. The jump-off will follow straight on from the first part of the course without stopping. All team and individual members will go forward to the second part of the second round (jump-off) unless eliminated. Should a team member be eliminated before reaching the jump-off phase and that team is tied for any placing, the team with the 4th member will take priority. For scoring purposes the second round and jump-off will be scored separately. At the discretion of the area, for team placings the second round times may be used to gain a result.

Approximate times will be provided once the entries have been received.

Other than the team competitions, all heights are approximate. Judges/Secretary have the right to refuse any entries and the Judge's decision is final. Finn Valley Riding Club accepts no responsibility for any damage to horses, people or their property.

BRC HAT STANDARDS

Hat tags must be the **turquoise** colour and be in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that they meet the current safety standards. They can be from other disciplines/bodies etc Pony Club, BE; they do not have to be BRC ones. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC rule book.

FLU VACCINATIONS (see rule G7)

The team manager MUST email the copy of each competing horse's passport details. This must include the passport name, full vaccination record and microchip number. Please can each horse's details be sent in a separate email with the horse's name, rider and club in the subject heading. Please can all team managers check everything is complete (you do not need to check the vaccination page but just ensure everything is present and not just simply forward on rider's email assuming it is correct). Please also forward any reserve horses details too then this will help in case of last minute changes.

The deadline for vaccination records and declaration forms to Linda Reed by Monday 14th February but please send in before if you have them.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

G6: Eligibility of Ponies/Horses

A table of eligibility can be found in the BRC Handbook and should be read in accordance with Appendix 3. Eligibility will be taken from the close of pre-entry. It is the riders responsibility to ensure they or their horse are eligible for the class they are entering and if in doubt to speak with their team manager.

G14.1: Making a protest

Protests or complaints may be lodged only by the chairman, team manager or nominated representative of the club concerned. These must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20. Please refer to rule G14 for full details.

ENTRIES (see rule G2.2)

Prelim entries must be made 21 days before the event by the 30th January. BRC have held over the pre entries from the cancelled November event.
